


- RHET Scottish Borders -

Farmhouse Breakfast Competition



Breakfast is the most important meal of the day. RHET Scottish Borders are launching a competition to encourage primary pupils to find out more about the origin of their breakfast.

As well as linking into 'the food experience', this year's challenge has a literacy focus linked to writing and creating texts.

We are looking for evidence of:

- Selecting, organising and conveying information in different ways
- Use of vocabulary and language for specific purposes

P1-3

Classes should put forward one project per class - with the Title "My Farmhouse Breakfast", and each project should contain at least 2 pieces of poetry, and various illustrations. Projects can take any format, wall display, project book or posters.

P4-7

Classes should put together a book of Poetry entitled "My Farmhouse Breakfast". At least 2 styles of poetry must be included, and pupils should illustrate their book. The book can be hand written, typed or a combination of both.

Some poetry styles you may like to consider:

- Senses poems (I see, I hear, I touch, I smell, I feel, etc.)
- Colour poems (Red is or red is the way I feel when..., Blue is..., green is..., etc.)
- Rhyming couplets
- Acrostic poems - using Breakfast as a start
- Writing a song/jingle or rap
- Scottish poem
- Haiku poems (only 17 syllables allowed, each new idea on a new line and usually the poem will have three to four lines, sometimes more sometimes less)

All entries to be in by 26th January 2018
