Cows start to go out to pasture



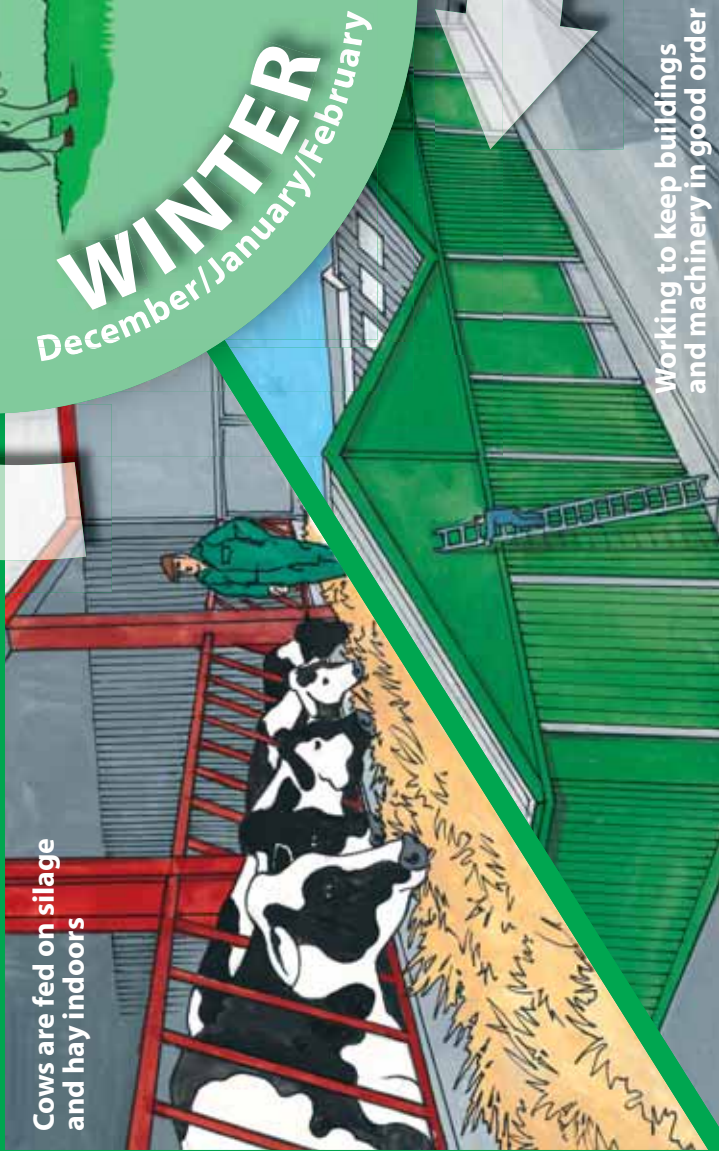
Silage-making

Cows are all out eating grass

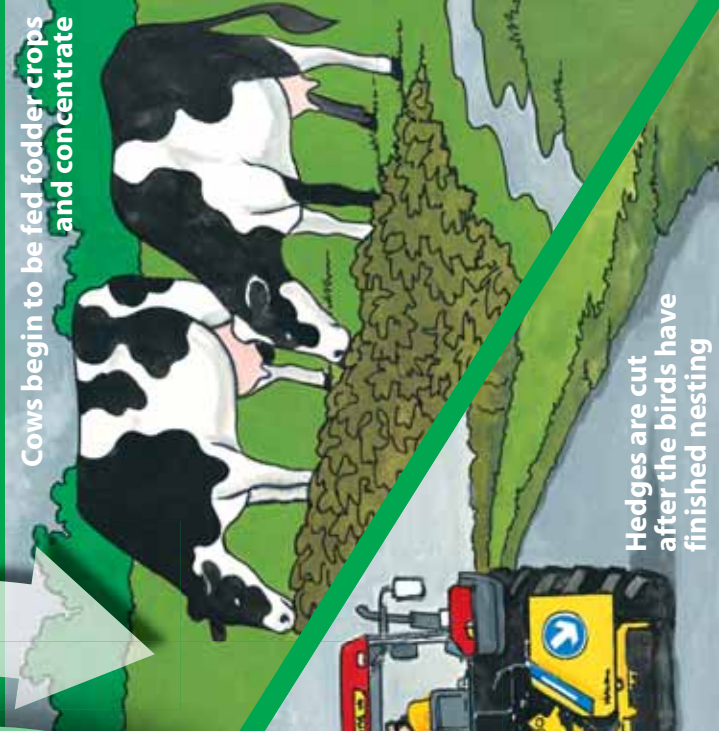


Cows are fed on silage and hay indoors
